

Stonehouse History Group Walks

Stonehouse History Group can offer several guided walks around the Stonehouse area, incorporating historic photos of local buildings and landmarks. We can tailor the walk to suit your group depending on distance and time. Most walks will take between 1 and 2 hours.

The Stroudwater Canal from Bond's Mill to Bridgend – we can do a variety of walks including the site of Beard's Mill and the railway viaduct.

St Cyr's Church – a visit to the Church can be incorporated in any of our walks. We may be able to arrange for your group to go up the Norman tower.

Stonehouse Court Hotel – our walks can include some of the history of the Court. You can arrange to have tea at the hotel after your walk.

World War Two – this walk includes the history of the Shadow Factories and the pillboxes along the canal.

High Street – this walk can be adapted to suit your group whether you want an easy short walk, a longer walk incorporating some of the side streets, or a particular theme such as a Victorian walk.

For a longer walk we can combine the **High Street and canal** which will take at least two hours.

We can also do history walks with **activities for children** to suit the age and ability of the group.

We normally charge £30 per group up to a maximum of 20 people. If you are a group of less than 10 we charge £3 per head.
