Queen Elizabeth II Coronation 1953 Celebrations in Stonehouse

In June 1953 the coronation of Queen Elizabeth II was celebrated. In Stonehouse there were decorated shops, parades, street parties, fancy dress competitions and a fete at Laburnum Field.

From Les Pugh's Memories (2003)

Reference to my diary for June 2nd 1953 tells me that Coronation Day was dull and stormy with a cool wind. On Saturday 30 May, I decorated the front of our house (in Crescent Road, Bridgend) with small Union Flags and fairy lights. On Sunday my wife Peggy and I attended a special Coronation evensong service at Cainscross Church.

Monday 1st June was a national holiday and I drove to Cheltenham via Stroud so that the family could view the decorations.

On Coronation Day we watched the television broadcasts of the ceremony at our neighbour's house. They were Mr and Mrs Don Dunkason and their daughter Glenis. They were one of a very few families to own a television set. It had a 9in screen and the picture was poor quality. After lunch we drove to Hoffmann's sports field where children's sports and a Punch and Judy Show had been

organised. At 9 pm we joined a torchlight procession to the top of Doverow Hill where a large bonfire was lit at 10 pm.






