- How familiar are you, or a member of your group/society, with the National Curriculum for History? Are you aware of what the National Curriculum defines as 'historical terms'?
- Can you identify any local place, event, issue or person that might interest you and children for
Infants Key Stage 1 (5 to 7/8 yrs)
Juniors Key Stage 2 (7/8 yrs to 10/11 yr)
Secondary Key Stage 3 (10/11 yrs to 15/16 yrs)
- Do you or a member already have links with local schools?
- How were these links established? Would you recommend this approach to others?
- Have you, or a member, led any local history events/talks/workshops in your local school? Can you identify what was successful? Or not successful?
- Can you identify who in your society might be best to establish links with a local school? Please forward these questions and the National Curriculum History statutory requirements, to whoever you have asked to accompany you on 9 September.
